A Bill for appointing an Agent in the United Kingdom of Great-Britain and Ireland, to folicit the passing of Laws, and for transacting the public affairs of this Province, was, according to order, read a second time.

On motion of Mr. Borgia, seconded by Mr. Taschereau;

RESOLVED, that the faid Bill be referred to a Committee of the whole House.

RESOLVED, that this House will, on Monday next, resolve itself into a Committee of the whole House, on the said Bill.

The order of the day for the House to resolve itself into a Committee of the whole House, on the Bill to amend an Act passed in the 39th year of His Majesty's reign, intituled, "An Act for the better "regulating the weights and measures of this Province;" and on the amendments reported by a special Committee to the said Bill, being read.

The House accordingly, resolved itself into the said Committee.

Mr. Speaker left the Chair.

Mr. Louis Roi took the Chair of the Committee.

Mr. Speaker refumed the Chair;

And Mr. Louis Roi reported, that the Committee had gone through the Bill, and had made fundry amendments thereto, which he was directed to fubmit to the House, whenever it should be pleased to receive the same.

ORDERED, that the report be now received.

And he read the report in his place, and afterwards delivered it,
