Know Ye, that I, the said Lieutenant-Governor, by virtue of the power and authority in  
 me vested, have constituted and appointed, and do, by these presents, constitute and ap-  
 point, the Honorable S. G. W. ARCHIBALD, J. W. JOHNSTON and PETER McNAB, or either  
 of them, to be a Commissioner or Commissioners to tender and administer the usual State  
 Oaths, according to Law, to all and every person and persons who is, are, or shall be, e-  
 lected a Member of the House of Assembly, in this Province, giving them, or either of  
 them, full power and authority to perform the matters hereinbefore mentioned, ratifying and  
 confirming all and whatsoever the said Commissioners, or either of them, shall do and per-  
 form in this behalf.
