Hundreds of our largest poultrymen who have the greatest success with fowls, both old and young, keep a constant supply of charcoal before their birds from the time they are first hatched until they are disposed of. Pure charcoal is one of the greatest disinfectants known, and will bring about the correction of troubles caused by irregularities in feeding quicker, perhaps, than almost anything that has ever been known to the poultry fraternity.

We keep it constantly before our birds and we seldom have a sick one. Of course it is not uncommon for all poultrymen to have fowls become suddenly sick and die, without any apparent cause whatever, it always being a profound mystery to the owner. But so far as permitting contagious diseases the use of charcoal will absolutely prevent any catastrophe of this kind. Of course it is expected that fowls are kept comfortable and in clean quarters. There is nothing will take the place of charcoal when it comes to putting the hens in good laying condition. Where it is used bowel trouble is seldom seen. It will prevent "little chick cholera" if fed freely to the breeders during the winter months; and if the powdered charcoal is used in mash for the growing chicks they will develop very rapidly and their growth never be checked by derangements of the digestive organs brought about by improper or irregular feeding.
