It was only lately that he had converted his business into an auto concern.

Mr. Murphy was a fourth degree, charter member, of the Knights of Columbus and a friend to rich and poor alike. Throughout his steady rise in business he had attained a host of friends. He also was one of the chief supporters of some of the various orphanages.

A widow, one daughter and two sons, the Rev. Eugene P. Murphy, S.J., a teacher at the Sacred Heart college, and John, a pupil at the Cathedral school survive Mr. Murphy.

No funeral arrangements have been made pending the arrival of Mr. Murphy's daughter, Ruth, from Washington, D.C., where she is attending Trinity college. Denver Post
