What Conservative Governments are Doing

In the matter of securing advantages for the people in the purchase of school books and other school supplies. Sir James Whitney Premier of Ontario and Mr. Hazen Premier of New Brunswick have come to the rescue of the people and have broken the monopolies that were oppressing the parents of school children.

Synopsis of Reduction in Ontario School Book Prices With Outline of What Will Be Done When Present Contracts and Copyrights Expire.

If the cut in readers was applied to all school books: Each P. S. pupil would save \$3. Each H. S. pupil would save \$11.89. Number of P. S. pupils in province 396,716. Number of H. S. pupils in province 30,337. Total saving to P. S. pupils, \$1,193,148. Total saving to H. S. pupils, \$363,397. Grand total saving, \$1,556,545.

The foregoing gives an idea of what may be expected when the Whitney government proceeds in the near future to deal with all public and high school books as it has already dealt with the public school readers.

REDUCTIONS TO COME. Then there are the others which are now ready for the axe. The list gives the books, exclusive of readers and copy-books, which each pupil will have to buy in order to get through the four forms in the public school.
