

U.S. NAVAL APPROPRIATION BILL.

WASHINGTON, Dec. 18. The naval appropriation bill, carrying a request of the President for negotiation with foreign powers relative to limiting the construction of war craft under ten thousand tons passed to-day in the House of Representatives. The bill carried a total of three hundred and twenty-five million dollars, and provides for an enlisted naval force of eighty-six thousand men, the same as fixed last year
