

OTTAWA STARTLED!

an Unexpected Freposal on the Part of the C. P. R. Company.

By an Unexpected Proposal on the Part of the C. P. R. Company.

Ottawa, Dec. 25.—President Van Horne, of the C. P. R., has sent a startling letter to Mayor Durocher through the C. P. R., solicitor here. After referring to the inconvenient situation of the sempany's depot here he says the C. P. R. have for some time been considering a scheme for a new entrance to the city. It is proposed to bridge the Ottawa River west of Gatineau Point to a point near Nepean Point, crossing Nepean Point near Nepean Point, orossing Nepean Point and the Rideau Canal. They then propose to tunnel under Parliament Hill, making a direct line through the city, with a passenger station near the mouth of the Rideau Canal in the center of the city. The latter asks for a municipal bonus of \$100,000, and threatens if the bonus is not granted to completely side-track Ottawa by running all through trains over the short line between Teronto and Montreal, connecting with Ottawa for local traffic by a branch line.

The latter is looked upon as an effort on

Kingsron, N. Y., Dec. 25.—A ctory of a girl being sold in marriage comes from New Lebanon, Columbia county. The case was brought to light by the arrest of Geo. Le Barnes, his wife, and Susan M. Dailey, the girl's mother, charged with intoxication. Le Barnes was sent to jail for six months for disorderly conduct, and the women were permitted to go.
