CHICAGO, July 22.—The Methodist meeting on the celebrated Desplaines camp meeting grounds was yesterday afternoon the scene of a most exciting occurrence. Two or three thousand people were atending divine service, when a cry for help came from the banks of the river. A rush was made and the first to arrive were met by two boys who said that two unknown men who had been in swimming had been drowned. Steps were immediately taken to recover the bodies and Rev. P. E. Colby, of the Crawford Methodist Church, this city, was the first to go to the resoue. Many times he dived for the bottom of the stream in the vicinity of where the men were said to have gone down, but without success. His repeated efforts, however, after about half an hour had clapsed were rewarded by his coming in contact with the bodies, clasped closely together in a deep hole breath the dam. For fully twenty minutes the preacher wrestled with the bodies, coming to the surface in the meantime only for air, but he found it impossible to extricate them. Finally with the assistance of two other men the bodies were brught up. Their arms and legs were clasped so tight that it was a most difficult matter to disentangle them. The remains have not been identified.
