NOW AN ADMIRAL. Captain Once Known Here Now Occupies High Position in Turkey.

Admirad Bucknam first made the acquaintance of the Sultan after being super intendent of marine at Cramps' shipyard two, years ago. While at Cramps' he tool the Mejeda, a war vessel the Turkish government had built there, to the land of the Sultan. He remained in Turkey several months, showing the officers there how to work the guns and explaining the operation of the vessel.

During his stay in Turkey Admirad Bucknam was introduced to the Sultan and seemed to take the fancy of the rules at once. It was not long before he of fered Bucknam the vice-admiralty of the navy if he would remain there. Admirad sucknam did not say that he would accept the position and returned to America A few mouths later the Sultan sent one on his representatives to this country to again offer the position to Bucknam. He finally consented, but before leaving Cramps Bucknam made a trip to San Francisco and married Miss Rose Thayer, and now for more than a year Bucknam has been an admiral of the Turkish navy.

ABSENT-MINDED TOURISTS. Some of Them Leave Behind Them in Hotels Even Their Children.
