Last year at Geneva they tried the effects of spraying an old orehard with a diluted Bordeaux mixture, one pound of copper sulphate in about 11 gallons of water. Spraying began on May 2, when some of the fruit buds were bursting. Another on May 19, when the first blossoms were opening. Another on May 31, when the last blossoms were felling. At this time one ounce of Paris green was added to 11 gallons of water, as it was on June 12 and June 28. Thus some of the trees had six sprayings and the balance had five. Other trees near them were left unsprayed. The fruit was picked, assorted, packed and sold by an experienced handler of fruit. 




