Exams Start Early This Year

Toronto, March 28.—The education department made some important announcements this morning concerning the holding of the annual departmental examinations for 1914. The junior high school entrance will be written on Wednesday, Thursday and Friday, June 17, 18 and 19, at usual provincial centers. Applicants must notify the inspector by April 15. The junior public school graduation examination occurs in the same week, and the same application restriction applies here. The senior public school graduation, senior high school entrance, model entrance examinations, as well as those of the lower school for faculty of education and normal entrance, are held in the week commencing Monday, June 8. The applications may be in by May 1. The honor and pass matriculation and upper school faculty entrance examinations begin on Thursday, June 11, with the middle school normal entrance papers starting on June 22, applications to be in by May 15. On Tuesday, August 18, the model schools will open, and a few weeks later on, September 1, the normal classes enroll. This latter date is three weeks earlier than usual and applications for model schools must be in to the deputy minister before August 15 and 29, respectively.

The name "Canada" means a large village or town in one of the dialects of the Huron-Iroquois tongue. In the first half of the sixteenth century it was applied to a district in the neighborhood of the Indian town of Stadacona, which stood on the site of the present city of Quebec. In the days of French occupation the name was more generally used more generally used than "New France" and sometimes was given to the whole country or what is known to-day as Quebec and Ontario. When the new Dominion made a step toward national life in 1867 "Canada" was adopted as the most appropriate designation. The name is thus a memorial of the Indian natives that once occupied the region on the Ottawa and Saguenay Rivers. We are glad it is so. The Spanish word Canada (Cay-nay-da) means a narrow canyon. The Portuguese Canay-da (Canada) means a small measure. The Indian word Cananda is evenly accented. The "large village" is still growing.

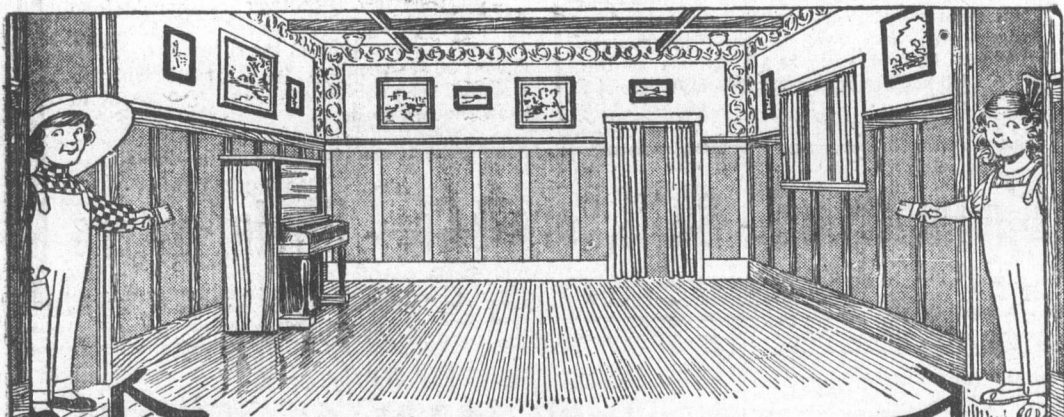
