FLOUR, GRAIN, &c.

Flour.—A fair range of values is said to be from \$4 50 to \$4 50 a ton and quality. Choice city brands sized at \$4 50 to \$4 50 in broken lots...

Outmeal.—We reduce our inside quotations as follows:—Rolled oats and granulated \$1.00 to \$1.10 per bushel, and in bags \$1.20 to \$1.25 standard in bulk, \$1.20 to \$1.25 in bags and \$1.25 to \$1.30 in bulk.

Barley.—A few cars of feed barley have been placed at 42c, and we quote 42c to 43c. In milling grades the only sale reported being a lot of 2000 bushels at 42c. Prices range 42c to 43c.

Wheat.—A fair quantity of No. 2 has been passed into the hands of exporters on May 1, but believed to be on the basis of 50c to 51c per bushel for May. Car lots of No. 2 are quoted at 47c and other grades 45c to 46c per bushel.

Secs.—Red clover quoted at \$7.50 to \$8 per bushel, Alsike 7c to 8c, and Timothy 2c to 2.25 for Canadian, and \$1.85 to \$1.90 for American.

PROVISIONS.

Pork, Lard, &c.—American regular mess pork has been offered freely at \$11 25, since the decline of 50c per bushel in Chicago. Lard is very quiet at \$1 35 to 1 40 per pound for compound.

Maple Products.—A lot of 100 gallons of very fine syrup was sold at 5c per lb. and we quote 4c to 5c for the same. Sugar is quoted at 22c to 23c for white, and 21c to 22c for brown. Old stock is 10c to 12c.

Butter.—Old creamery butter sales have been made at 18c to 19c. Fine new creamery is being delivered to grocers here in 5 lb. packages at 22c by certain farmers in the Townships.

Cheese.—The new make is coming in more liberally in lots of 40 to 50 boxes, costing 10c to 11c in bulk here, according to quality.
