I have the honour to confirm receipt of Your Excellency's note no. DFR-820 of May 24, 1972, regarding the training of Dutch student pilots in Canada, which in the Dutch version reads as follows:

I have the honour to inform Your Excellency that the proposals for the abovementioned training curriculum as contained in your note, are acceptable to the Government of the Kingdom of the Netherlands, and that your note and this reply together will form an Agreement between the Government of the Kingdom of the Netherlands and the Government of Canada, which for the present will be applied as from the date of this reply, and will be effective retroactively as of September 1, 1971, at the time at which both Governments inform each other in writing that they have obtained the internal approval which each of them might need in order to put this Agreement in operation.
