## Canada-Philippines Business Ventures

### A. Companies Owned or Partly Owned by Canadian Interests

COMPANY	ACTIVITY
Asia International Business Centre	Small firm engaged in providing business, trading and immigration consulting services.
Consultation Nadeau International Inc.	CNI is currently involved in an educational consulting project with the ADB, and is pursuing other consulting opportunities.
Diversey (Phils)	This firm, wholly owned by Diversey of Canada, is involved in the manufacture and distribution of industrial chemicals.
Gardex Electronics (Phil) Inc.	Firm involved in the manufacturing and installation of closed-circuit TV systems. An associated company, Triton Farms Inc., is engaged in poultry farming.
G.M. Gest Philippines Inc.	G.M. Gest established a Philippine company for the management of telecommunications projects. In early 1990, the company completed the installation of a fibre-optic link between the trans-Pacific underwater cable and Manila, and now have a large subcontract to upgrade Philippine Long Distance Telephone (PLDT) facilities.
Intercap	This recently formed joint venture, 15 per cent owned by Capsule Technology, will be producing hard gelatin capsules for the pharmaceutical industry.
McPhar Geoservices	McPhar maintains a branch office providing geochemical and geophysical services.
Marcopper	This company, the third largest copper producer in the Philippines, operates an open-pit mine and concentrator on Marinduque Island in the central Philippines. It is partly owned by Placer Dome.
Mar-Fishing	This company, effectively Canadian-controlled through joint ownership by Marcopper and B.C. Packers, operates a deep-sea tuna fleet and cannery in Mindanao.
Manufacturer's Life Insurance	Manufacturer's is Canadian-owned, and an important life insurance firm in the Philippines.
Philwatch Inc.	Firm involved in the assembly of children's watches.
