AUSTRALIA

What is it?

The program allows young Canadians to visit Australia for a maximum of 12 months and to supplement their funds by taking temporary employment.

Work may be part- or full-time. However, the main purpose of the visit should be to holiday and travel. Participants are not permitted to remain with any one employer for more than three months. They also may not enrol in a course of studies while in Australia, other than a short-term English language training course.

HOW LONG IS IT?

Visas are valid for 12 months from the date of issue, and allow for a total stay of 12 months from the date of entry into Australia.

Admission requirements

To be eligible, you must be:

- 18 to 25 years of age (there is no student status requirement);
- a Canadian citizen; and
- in possession of a valid passport.

What to do to participate

For an application form, send a request by letter (not fax) to the Australian High Commission. Enclose a stamped self-addressed envelope with \$1.00 postage.
