The Canadian Government has received a request from the United States Government to join in a reference to the International Joint Commission for a survey on the feasibility of the proposed Passamaquoddy tidal power project. The Government has agreed to join with the United States in this reference (including investigations into the effect the proposed project might have upon fisheries) and discussions will shortly take place between the two governments on the terms of the reference to be submitted to the International Joint Commission and on the share of the costs to be assumed by Canada and the United States.
