Mr. Wilfred Andrew Rose, first High Commissioner to Canada for Trinidad and Tobago, this morning presented his Letter of Introduction to the Prime Minister of Canada, the Right Honourable John G. Diefenbaker. The High Commissioner was introduced by the Chief of Protocol, Mr. Henry F. Davis.

Born in 1916, Mr. Rose was educated in Trinidad and in London, England. He is married.

From 1958 until his present appointment he served as Minister of Communications and Works in the former West Indies Federal Government.

Trinidad and Tobago, a former British West Indian Colonial territory, became an independent member of the Commonwealth on August 31, 1962.
