PRAYERS

Mr. Dionne (Northumberland-Miramichi) for Mr. Cyr, from the Standing Committee on Indian Affairs and Northern Development, presented the Fourth Report of the Committee, which is as follows:

Pursuant to its Order of Reference of Friday, April 11, 1975, your Committee has considered Bill S-20, An Act to amend the Territorial Lands Act, and has agreed to report it without amendment.

A copy of the Minutes of Proceedings and Evidence relating to this Bill (*Issue No. 28*) is tabled.

Washington, May 8, 1975, in force May 8, 1975. (English and French).—Sessional Paper No. 301-6/136A.
