An Act respecting the appointment of Auditors for National Railways.

IIS Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as follows:-

Appointment of auditors.

1. Notwithstanding the provisions of section thirteen of The Canadian National-Canadian Pacific Act, 1933, chapter thirty-three of the statutes of 1932-33, as enacted by section three of chapter twenty-five of the statutes of 1936, respecting the appointment of auditors by joint resolution of the Senate and House of Commons. George A. Touche and Company, of the cities of Toronto and Montreal, 10 chartered accountants, are appointed as independent auditors for the year 1946, to make a continuous audit under the provisions of the said section, of the accounts of National Railways as defined in the said Act.
