(a) An affirmative vote on Motion No. 40 disposes of Motion No. 41. A negative vote on Motion No. 40 necessitates a vote on Motion No. 41.

(b) An affirmative vote on Motion No. 42 disposes of Motion No. 43. A negative vote on Motion No. 42 requires a vote on Motion No. 43.

(c) An affirmative vote on Motion No. 45 will also dispose of Motions Nos. 46 and 47. A negative vote on Motion No. 45 will require separate votes on Motions Nos. 46 and 47.

(d) An affirmative vote on Motion No. 48 will dispose of Motions Nos. 50 and 51. A negative vote on Motion No. 48 requires separate votes on Motions Nos. 50 and 51.

Seventh, Motion Nos. 52, 54 to 63 inclusive and 66 to 68 inclusive shall be grouped for debate and voted on in the following manner:

(a) An affirmative vote on Motion No. 52 will also dispose of Motion Nos. 54 to 59 inclusive. A negative vote on Motion No. 52 will necessitate votes on Motions Nos. 54 to 59 inclusive, as follows:

(i) An affirmative vote on Motion No. 54 would obviate the need for a vote on Motions Nos. 55, 56 and 57. A negative vote on Motion No. 54 requires separate votes on Motions Nos. 55, 56 and 57.

(ii) An affirmative vote on Motion No. 58 would preclude the putting of the question on Motion No. 59. A negative vote on Motion No. 58 would require a vote on Motion No. 59.

(b) An affirmative vote on Motion No. 60 will dispose of Motions Nos. 61 to 63 inclusive. A negative vote on Motion No. 60 requires the question to be put on Motions Nos. 61, 62 and 63 as follows:

(i) An affirmative vote on Motion No. 61 would obviate the putting of the question on Motion No. 62. A negative vote on Motion No. 61 requires a vote on Motion No. 62.

(ii) Motion No. 63 would be voted on separately.

(c) An affirmative vote on Motion No. 66 precludes the question being put on Motions Nos. 67 and 68. A negative vote on Motion No. 66 would require separate votes on Motions Nos. 67 and 68.

Eighth, Motions Nos. 75, 77, 78 and 79 should be grouped for debate. An affirmative vote on Motion No. 77 will dispose of Motions Nos. 78 and 79. A negative vote on Motion No. 77 will require the question to be put on Motion No. 78 and, a vote on Motion No. 78 disposes of Motion No. 79. Motion No. 75 will be voted on separately.

Ninth, Motions Nos. 85 and 86 are to be grouped for debate. An affirmative vote on Motion No. 85 disposes of Motion No. 86. A negative vote on Motion No. 85 requires a vote on Motion No. 86.

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Tenth, Motions Nos. 95, 96 and 97 should be grouped for debate. An affirmative vote on Motion No. 95 will dispose of

Motions Nos. 96 and 97. A negative vote on Motion No. 95 will require separate votes on Motions Nos 96 and 97.

Eleventh, Motions Nos 99 to 102 inclusive will be grouped for debate and voted on as follows:

(a) An affirmative vote on Motion No. 99 will dispose of Motion No. 100. A negative vote on Motion No. 99 will require a vote Motion No. 100.

(b) An affirmative vote on Motion No. 101 disposes of Motion No. 102. A negative vote on Motion No. 101 requires a vote on Motion No. 102.

Twelfth, Motions Nos. 108 and 109 should be grouped for debate. An affirmative vote on Motion No. 108 disposes of Motion No. 109. A negative vote on Motion No. 108 requires a vote on Motion No. 109.

12. (a) Motions Nos. 113 and 114 should be grouped for debate. An affirmative vote on Motion No. 113 disposes of Motion No. 114. A negative vote on Motion No. 113 requires a vote on Motion No. 114.

Thirteenth, Motions Nos. 116, 118 to 123 inclusive should be grouped for debate and voted on as follows:

(a) An affirmative vote on Motion No. 116 will dispose of Motion No. 118. A negative vote on Motion No. 116 requires the question to be put on Motion No. 118.

(b) An affirmative vote on Motion No. 119 will dispose of Motion No. 120. A negative vote on Motion No. 119 will require a vote on Motion No. 120.

(c) An affirmative vote on Motion No. 121 will dispose of Motion No. 122. A negative vote on Motion No. 121 requires a vote on Motion No. 122.

(d) Motion No. 123 will be voted on separately.

Fourteenth, Motions Nos 129 and 130 should be grouped for debate. An affirmative vote on Motion No. 129 will dispose of Motion No. 130. A negative vote on Motion No. 129 requires a vote on Motion No. 130.

Fifteenth, Motion Nos. 138 and 139 should be grouped for debate. An affirmative vote on Motion No. 138 will dispose of Motion No. 139. A negative vote on Motion No. 138 requires a vote on Motion No. 139.

Sixteenth, Motions Nos. 140 and 141 should be grouped for debate. An affirmative on Motion No. 140 will dispose of Motion No. 141. A negative vote on Motion No. 140 requires a vote on Motion 141.

Seventeenth, Motions Nos. 151 to 155 inclusive will be grouped for debate and voted on as follows:

(a) An affirmative vote on Motion No. 151 will dispose of Motions Nos. 152 to 155 inclusive. A negative vote on Motion No. 151 requires the question to be put on the remaining motions in this group, as follows:

(i) An affirmative vote on Motion No. 152 disposes of Motion No. 153. A negative vote on Motion No. 152 requires a vote on Motion No. 153.

(ii) Motions Nos. 154 and 155 are to be voted on separately.
