August 28th, 1931. The Editor, The Gazette. Montreal. Dear Sir: In this morning's issue there appears an editorial entitled " A University and Hospital Zone". This is, I believe, the first editorial comment you have made with reference to the proposed erection of a convention hall over the McTavish Street reservoir, and you refer to a conference the University authorities had with civic representatives last Wednesday. May I say that your comment does not represent fairly what took place at the conference. I am the University authority who attended that conference on Wednesday last. I first heard of this project by seeing an issue of the Montreal Hezald of August 7th on the front page of which appeared a cut of the "Million Dollar Convention Hall for Montreal". I presume the Gazette also noted this news. I immediately wrote to Alderman Weldon and asked him to inform me
