

# SYLLABUS OF THE GRAMMAR

1. **THE ALPHABET.**—The letters of the English alphabet, and the names of the letters.

2. **THE VOWELS.**—The five vowels, and the diphthongs formed by them.

3. **THE CONSONANTS.**—The twenty-four consonants, and the combinations of letters which represent them.

4. **THE ACCENT.**—The three accents, and the rules for their use.

5. **THE PUNCTUATION.**—The marks of punctuation, and the rules for their use.

6. **THE GRAMMATICAL CASES.**—The nominative, genitive, dative, accusative, and locative cases; and the forms of nouns, adjectives, and pronouns in each case.

7. **THE PRINCIPAL PARTS OF VERBS.**—The present, past, and future tenses, and the principal parts of regular verbs, and the forms of irregular verbs.

8. **THE PARTS OF SPEECH.**—The nine parts of speech, and the forms of each.

9. **THE GRAMMATICAL CONSTRUCTIONS.**—The constructions of simple and compound sentences.

10. **THE GRAMMATICAL MODES.**—The modes of narration, description, exhortation, and exhortation, and the forms of each.

11. **THE GRAMMATICAL TENSES.**—The tenses of verbs, and the forms of each.

12. **THE GRAMMATICAL MOODS.**—The moods of verbs, and the forms of each.
