lno, I loose—analyze, analysis, palsy, paralytic.
lyra, a lyre—lyric, lyrical, lyrist, lyrated.

machô, a fight—logomachy, monomachy, naumachy, sciomachy.
mania, madness—maniac, monomania, bihomania.
martyr, a witness—martyr, martyrdom, martyrology, protomartyr.
manthano (*math*), learn—philomath, polymathy, mathematics, -tical.
mechanê, a machine—mechanic, mechanics, mechanism, machine, machinist.
melos, a song—melody, melodious, melodrama; Philomel.
metron, a measure—metre, metrical, barometer, diameter, geometry, perimeter, eymetry, thermometer, trigonometry.
micros, small—microscopic, microcosm, micrography, micrology.
miseo, I hate—misanthrope, misogynist, misogynist.
mnêma, memory—mnemonics, mnemotechny, amnesty.
