

**hedra**, a seat—cathedral, sanhedrim, polyhedron, etc.  
**héllios**, the sun—heliocentric, helloscope, heliotrope, aphelion, perihelion, parhelion.  
**hémera**, a day—ephemera, ephemeral, ephemeris.  
**heteros**, another—heteroclite, heterodox, heterogeneous.  
**hieros**, sacred—hierarchy, hieroglyphic, hierography, hierophant.  
**histémi**, to place—apostate, ecstacy, etatics, statistic, system, systematize.  
**hodos**, a way—episode, exodus, method, -ist, -ical, period, -ical, synod.  
**homos**, like—homogeneous, homologous, homonymous.  
**hndōr**, water—hydraulics, hydrogen, hydrophobia, hydrostatics, anhydrous.  
**humneō**, I sing—hymn, hymnal, hymnology.

**Idios**, idiom—idiot, idiocy, idiosyncrasy.  
**iso-**, equal (in composition)—isochronous, isosceles, isothermal.

**lambano** (*leps*), I take—syllable, catelpsy, epilery.  
**laos**, the people—laity, laic, lay, as opposed to clerical.  
**legō**, I speak or collect—lexicon, dialect, eclectic, elegy, prolegomena.  
**lithos**, a stone—aerolite, lithography, lithotomy, monolith.  
**logos**, a word—logic, analogy, apologue, catalogue, decalogue, dialogue, entomology, geology, neology, theology, zoology, etc.  
**lno**, I loose—analyze, analysis, palsy, paralytic.  
**lyra**, a lyre—lyric, lyreal, lyrast, lyrated.

**machō**, a fight—logomachy, monomachy, naumachy, sciomachy.  
**mania**, madness—maniac, monomania, blhliomania.  
**martyr**, a witness—martyr, martyrdom, martyrology, protomartyr.  
**manthano** (*math*), learn—philomath, polymathy, mathematics, -tical.  
**mechanē**, a machine—mechanic, mechanics, mechanism, machination, mechanist.  
**melos**, a song—melody, melodious, melodrama; Philomei.  
**métrron**, a measure—metre, metrical, harometer, diameter, geometry, perimeter, eynometry, thermometer, trigonometry.  
**micros**, small—microscopic, microcosm, micrography, micrology.  
**miseo**, I hate—misanthrope, misognyle, misogamist.  
**mnēma**, memory—mnemonics, mnemotechny, amnesty.  
**monos**, one—monad, monarch, monarchy, monk, monastic, monopoly, monotheism, monotony.  
**morphē**, shape—amorphous, metamorphose, polymorphous.  
**mythos**, a fable—myth, mythical, mythology.
