Chicago, July 11.—Corn weakened today for old crop deliveries, but strengthened for the new crop month, December. There was much sentiment that July and September were too near the basic price of wheat; on the other hand, notice that trade relations with Germany could at once be resumed led some speculators to favor the old crop.

Most of the corn trade was in the December option, and there was evidence that the bulls especially in this connection, some friends of higher prices professed to feel apprehensive that the south would cause damage. Other authorities, however, said that the market was not so near the subject of renewed business with Germany.
