

CANCEL PAVING CONTRACTS CONTROLLERS ACCEPT HIM

Blownness in Getting to Work Excuse
for Complaint Voiced by
Mr. Rust.

Some of the paving companies are not so energetic in carrying out their contracts as they are hustling to secure those same contracts. This was the natural conclusion to be drawn from a letter from the city engineer read before the board of control. Mr. Rust estimated that there were many complaints about the leisurely manner in which the Warren Bros. Co. were going about the laying down of certain concrete sidewalks. "I see no other course open but to ask your board to cancel the contracts and instruct the city engineer to carry out the same by day labor," this was Mr. Rust's analysis of the situation.

Testimony to the way in which the companies have been resting upon their laurels was given by the city's road-way engineer, who also indicated that Concrete Limited was a kind of offshoot of the Warren Bros. Co., being made up of two former employees of the latter company. Concrete Limited had not got 17 of 18 contracts upon which it should have begun two months ago, but still were operations delayed. Mr. Rust's prescribed course was to get some discussion as to whether the company could be held to its ten-year warranty, and it was decided to have the city solicitor's opinion. The controllers agreed that the contracts should be cancelled.

Controller Shaw's motion that an ambulance be recommended for use in the west end met the fate of being ruled out of court. The controller contended that the time lost in getting a down-town ambulance in cases of emergency, and replying to Controller Hubbard's remark that there were two ambulances kept by the undertakers, that their service was charged for like that of a hearse. However, the controllers thought the police commissioners were the proper body to be approached.

MINING DISPUTES SETTLED.

Commissioner Price Hands Report on Cobalt Cases to Minister.

Sam Price of St. Thomas, who went to New Ontario to take evidence in a number of disputes as to the ownership of mining claims, handed his report to the government yesterday. He investigated 15 disputes, taking evidence in all and submitting a report as to the rightful ownership in four cases which arose before the Cobalt cases were made a mining division. The disputants in these four cases were: Haines, Kay and Harvey; Hennessey and Hinds; Haines and Scully; Graham, Bowen and McCleskey. In the eleven other cases only the evidence was taken. The decision of Hon. Frank Cochrane will be final. The disputes were of priority of location and as to discovery of valuable ores.

WHEN IS A LANE NOT A LANE.
