In the weekly statement Bank of England coin and bullion shows an increase of £80,000, although £50,000 in gold was exported for the week, the explanation being that cash is now returning from home circulation, after the holidays. The decrease of £80,000, and the return generally is stronger than a year ago, when the bank rate was only 2 per coat.

Details of the gold movement for the week show the sale of £125,000 in French coin for New York, Cuba being the utilmate destination, and the receipt of £75,000 from Australia.
