## FITZHERBERT AT 3 TO 5 WINS THE BROOKLYN

Olamballa Was Second and Prince Imperial Third—The Summary.

GRAVESEND RACE TRACK, New York, May 31.—The Brooklyn Handicap, its glory dimmed by recent anti-betting legislation, its value as a stake shrunk to \$6000 as compared with \$10,000 two years ago, was won to-day in easy fashion by San Hildreth's Fitzherbert in the presence of a thinned out crowd variously estimated at between 8000 and 8500 persons.

R. T. Wilson, Jr., Olamballa finished second, and a length behind the winner, and a head in front of Prince Imperial, the entry of the Woodlawn Stable.

The race, which had frequently brought together in the past 40,000 and 50,000 spectators and the pick of the thoroughbred America, was contested to-day by a rare half dozen starters. Fitzherbert at 3 to 5, easily outclassed the field, and the race was his from the start. Under the guidance of Jockey Dugan, loosed by August Belmont for the occasion, the champion 4-year-old took the lead from the moment the barrier was shot up and was never in front of the winner, the entire 1 1/4 miles. Running with easy strides he won as he pleased, at times distancing the field by three full lengths.

Olamballa, with Butwell, up and quoted at 4 to 1 for a place, fought it out gamely with Prince Imperial down the stretch and crossed the tape second, a head in front of the Woodlawn entry, on which odds of 3 to 5 for third were quoted.

The time, 2:06 3/5, although not as fast as the last two runnings of the Brooklyn Handicap, compared favorably with the average since 1887, when the stake was first offered. It had been expected that slight horses would contest to-day, among them Glucose of the Newmarket Stable, and Hildreth's Prestone, but the field narrowed down to six, including, besides the place winners, Clear, Fashion Plate and Duma Ken, which finished as 10th, 11th and 12th.

Under a recent interpretation placed upon the anti-betting law by the supreme court of the state, oral wagers made within the passing of money in public were not illegal, and the bookmaking fraternity made the most of it to-day. The new law covering oral betting is not effective until Sept. 1. Results:
