the people in Yucatan were in abject ser-vitude. After the enactment of the land laws, the labor legislation was framed on the best models to be found in New Zealand and other parts of the world, modified to fit the conditions of Yucatan. They have minimum wage provisions and an eight-hour law, com-pensation for injuries of workmen and provision for their old sge. Children un-der thirteen cannot be employed in fac-tories or any other establishment. Boys under fifteen and girls under eighteen cannot work nights. All places of em-ployment must be sanitary and protected against fire-risks, and all machinery must be protected. Compulsory arbitra-tion of labor disputes is provided by law before workers can strike or employers lock them out.

The benefits of a parcels post ar-rangement between Canada and Russia are indicated in the fact that one of the notable features of the vast inflow of goods to Russia thru the Pacific port of Viadivostok is the large use made by the Japanese of the Russian parcels post, which by treaty is open to the Japanese for the forwarding of small parcels. A very large aggregate bulk of goods com-ing to Vladivostok by sea is at that port broken up into small packages which are then put into the post.


