The Wesleyan Conference in England employs sixteen Missionaries and two assistants in Nova Scotia, Prince Edward Island and Cape Breton, towards whose support the Wesleyan Missionary Committee make a liberal annual grant. But a missicary Society, auxiliary to the Wesleyan Missionary Society in London, and having Branch Societies on all the Circuits in the province, has for these last seventeen years contributed to the general objects of the Parent Institution. An annual subscription of 5s or upwards constitutes membership and entitles to the District Report. The anniversary is held in May, wherever the district committee holds its sessions.---The Annual District Meeting of Wesleyan Ministers will commence in Halifax on the 4th Thursday in May, 1835.

There are Penny-a-Week Societies in Truro and Onslow; the money collected is appropriated to missions, and the purchase of books, principally for children. In the Lower District of Sydney, there are a Dorcas Society; and a Society for sending Bibles to the Burmans.
