No. 16421 I have the honour to say that, in accordance with your instructions, I interviewed Chief Thunderchild and his Indians; but they walk not say where they will locate their proposed new Reserve, until the Snow is off the ground. In talking the subject over they incidentally mentioned that they very much wished the new Reserve to Louch, at some point, Turtle Lake. As soon as the Snow is off the ground I am goin with them to look for a suitable location; and will report to the Department, their choice, at the moment possible.
