FOR PRESERVATION OF THE SALMON OF FRASER RIVER, B. C.

Victoria, B. C., Feb. 12—"Fraser River
Salmon Situation, a Reclamation Project,"
is the title of an interesting brochure
written by John Pease Babcock,
assistant to the provincial commissioner
of fisheries. Mr. Babcock reiterates
the warnings given more than one
occasion by the provincial department
of Fisheries as to the need of drastic
conservation methods in order that the
Fraser river run may be prevented from
becoming exterminated altogether, and
concludes with the suggestion that the
restoration of the sockeye salmon fish-
ery of the Fraser river systems is the
greatest reclamation project in which
Canada and the United States can
jointly engage, and that, too, with the
least expense and most certain results.

"The lake waters of the Fraser river
basin cover an area of 1,814,000 acres,
when seeded by spawning sockeye
as abundantly as they are produced
annually a run of sockeye salmon from
which may be taken sufficient fish to
fill 1,277,002 cases, worth \$30,000,000,
without an overdraw on the run," says
Mr. Babcock.

CANADA, THE HOME OF AVIATORS

(By C. G. Grey, in the Illustrated Lon-
don News.)
The Dominion of Canada seems likely
to be one of the busiest parts of the
world where flying seems to be
appealing more to the Canadian temper-
ment than to most others. And, by a
merciful dispensation, Canada is topo-
graphically and geographically better
suited to be served by aircraft than is
almost any other part of the earth's
surface. As regards the fact that it is
borne out by the fact that by the
end of the war some 15,000 Canadian
had learned to fly. One doubted the
figure when it was mentioned; but when
one recalls how many Canadians joined
the R. N. A. S. and the R. F. C. in the
earliest days of the war, and how an
ever-increasing number of them were
trained as aviators in Canada and in
Great Britain, one begins to believe that
the figure is under rather than over the
mark. It is well to remember in this
connection that there were 30,000 officers
altogether in the R. N. A. S. and the R. F. C.
the war, and that some of the Canadian
aviators were N. C. O.'s and men, and
some were even regular army officers.
Still, the number is remarkable in itself.
And most of those men went on to
flying when they came back to Canada.
Now as regards the suitability of the
country for flying. A most elementary
knowledge of eastern Canada suggests at
once that there are immense possibilities
for seaplanes all the way from New-
foundland to the Gulf St. Lawrence and
the St. Lawrence river to the western
limits of the Great Lakes. And a
very general notion of western Canada
conveys the idea that the great coun-
try and cattle plains of Manitoba and Al-
berta afford ideal country for ordinary
land-going aeroplanes. But in fact the
possibilities are far greater than might
appear. For to the west of the Great
Lakes are big rivers and lakes of mod-
erate size which afford easy alighting
places for seaplanes and sunken flying
boats, even if not for the great multi-
engine flying-boats of the Felixstowe
type which would be used on the larger
waters of eastern Canada. A Canadian
friend, himself a pilot of great skill,
has a singularly fine war record, tells
one that a capable pilot on a good mod-
ern seaplane could fly westward to the
coast of the Rockies, and that if he
were prepared to take a little extra risk
for once, he could get over the Rockies
and down to the Pacific coast without
any very great danger.
