Daily Hints For the Cook

MY BROWN BREAD.
One cup flour, one cup corn meal, one cup Graham flour, teaspoon of salt, two teaspoons baking powder, one cup milk, one cup water, half cup molasses, one cup of raisins floured. Mix all together, grease brown bread tin. Fill two-thirds full and cover tight. Place in a kettle of boiling water, cover kettle and boil for four hours. Then place in oven and bake one-half hour.

WEBSTER PUDDING.
One cup of molasses, one cup of milk, half cup melted butter, half cup of brandy or wine, one teaspoon of soda, one teaspoon of cinnamon, cloves and a little nutmeg, one pound currants and a little salt. Mix as soft as pound cake and steam or boil two hours. Hard or wine sauce. What is left can be steamed over and over. This receipt may be reduced by one-half.

MAY ABOLISH COMMUNION CUP IN TORONTO CHURCHES

(Toronto Telegram).

From the books and things at present in the Medical Health Department the single communion cup in Toronto's churches will be the next item of the old regime to fall before the medical health department. "Of course," said Doctor Hastings, when he discussed the matter with The Telegram, "this might be considered as a mere drop in the bucket in the matter of disease communication, but when you consider that some churches have a regular communion service every Sunday and that sometimes a few hundred persons partake the serious side of the question becomes apparent."

"What type of disease would be liable or subject to transportation by this means?" he was asked. "Tuberculosis and

diphtheria could be carried by this means. Of course if our investigation should show that this matter be carried out we would probably meet with considerable opposition from the churches that cling to the old forms, but we would have ample grounds to back up any movement of this kind on our part. "After all," said the doctor, "the individual cup is by far the best method of conducting this service."

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Commissioner Agar introduced the programme for permanent pavements and it was decided to proceed with work under the Local Improvements Act, which provides that half the cost will be paid by the owners of the properties benefited.

The expenditure involved will amount to about \$12,000. The programme includes: British street—Between Charlotte street and Beale's Point, granite block paving, total cost, \$23,850; cost per lineal foot to abutting property, \$3.27.

Union street—Waterloo street to Brunel street, granite block paving; total cost, \$8,800; cost per lineal foot to abutting property, \$4.65.

North side—King Square—Bituminous macadam, vitrified brick and concrete; total cost, \$9,894.95; cost per lineal foot to abutting property, \$3.90.

Union street—Chipman Hill to Waterloo street, asphalt; total cost, \$17,455; cost per lineal foot to abutting property, \$3.77.

Charlotte street—Dufferin hotel to Queen street, bituminous macadam and vitrified brick; total cost, \$29,400; cost per lineal foot to property, \$3.00.

Princes street—Germain street to Charlotte street, asphalt; total cost, \$4,127.50; cost per lineal foot to abutting property, \$2.90.

Germain street—Princes to King street, bituminous concrete; total cost, \$8,028.75; cost per lineal foot to abutting property, \$3.70.

Germain street—King street to Union street, granite block paving; total cost, \$9,922.50; cost per lineal foot to abutting property, \$4.82.

South side of King Square—Asphalt; total cost, \$6,800; cost per lineal foot to property owners, \$3.50.

Sydney street—West side of King Square to Union street, sheet asphalt and granite blocks; total cost, \$8,700; cost per lineal foot, \$0.65.

In addition to the foregoing Paradise Row from Mill street to Foundry Lane is to be paved with granite blocks at an estimated cost of \$7,000 which would cost per lineal foot of frontage \$5.90. It is expected that arrangements will be made for the paving of other streets.

WIFE SUES LEADING WOMAN IN HUSBAND'S COMPANY FOR \$50,000

New York, Feb. 18.—As a sequel to the application of Theodore Roberts, an actor, to defeat his wife's claim for \$50,000 allowance, Mrs. Roberts has filed a \$50,000 demand for alleged alienation of affections. Mrs. Roberts said she had decided not to ask for a divorce, because of her religious belief.

The report of the divorce court was submitted. The Trades and Labor Council wrote approving of the plan for an ambulance service along the water front and Committee members reported that he was taking steps to put this plan into effect.
