The victims are: Mr. and Mrs. Aurel Lavigne, aged 21 and 18, Mrs. Romeo Pelosse, aged 19 and her 11 months old baby Romeo Pelosse Jr. The fifth occupant of the boat, Aurere Gatien, aged four, sister of Mrs. Pelosse, was saved. The baby was taken out of the water but was already dead.


