LONG SAHARAN JOURNEY.

Capt. Buchanan Accomplishes Scientific Mission.

Marseilles, June 10. (By mail.)—Captain Angus Buchanan, who has crossed the Sahara by camel, a journey of nearly four thousand miles, arrived at Marseilles this afternoon on board the steamship Charlevoix from Algiers. The explorer, who is none the worse for his adventurous journey, was welcomed on the quay by friends resident in Marseilles.

Captain Buchanan, who was carrying out a commission to study the geography and zoology of the Sahara, has successfully accomplished his mission. He succeeded in crossing the Hoggar without great difficulty, but found the intense heat very trying. He was welcomed en route by the French military authorities, who did all that was possible to help him on the way.
