


Gentlemen:-

 I beg to acknowledge receipt of your letter of the 30th.ult. enclosing cheque for the sum of \$327.60 covering rental and renewal fee for timber license No.224 (Katit) for season 1936-37 and reply to point out that it is necessary under the conditions of your license to make a statement under oath, that you are still the bona fide owners of this limit.
