Extract of Minute of Meeting of Committee of Nova Scotia Auxiliary Bible Society, held on Monday, the 3rd day of October, 1864.

The subject of gratuitous distribution of the Scriptures was discussed:

And it was resolved, That all grants of Bibles for the future shall be on the understanding that they be paid for a half price. And that to country places on the recommendation of the officers of the nearest local Society only. It being understood that each member of the Committee shall be entitled to give an order for a Bible or a Testament to any person whom he may think requires it.

And that the above resolution be published in the Anna Report, that all concerned may govern themselves accordingly.
