and were overwhelmingly against the surrender; only three,
I think, speaking decidedly in its favor. I would have
returned on Monday had the vote been near a tie, or had
there been any hope of an immediate change, but as matters
stood it seemed useless to prolong the negotiations, and
we returned to Battleford the same evening. I wired you
next morning the results.

I place herewith a deposit receipt in favor of the Receiver General for \$15,000.00, the amount intended for Moosomin's Band.
