BY LAWS.

At a meeting of the Council of the Municipality of the County of Northumberland, held at the Council Chamber, Newcastle, on Tuesday, the eighteenth day of January, A. D. 1881.

Resolved, That the following Bye-Laws be made and established for the government of the said Municipality.

A BYE-LAW Relating to Dogs.

Be it ordained by the Municipal Council of the County of Northumberland:

1. That a tax of \$1.00 shall be imposed on the owner, keeper or harbinger of each and every dog, within the limits of the front lots in the Lower District of the Parish of Chatham.

A BYE-LAW Relating to the going at large of Cattle.

Be it ordained by the Municipal Council of the County of Northumberland:

1. That Section 4 of the Bye-Laws relating to the going at large of cattle and fowls passed at April Sittings 1876, so far as the same relates to the Parish of Chatham, be repealed and in lieu thereof, that no ox, cow, or neat cattle, shall be suffered or allowed to go or be at large at any time of the year, in that part of the said Parish, lying between the old Napan road and the street or road leading past the St. John's Church Burying Ground, and extending back to Howard Street.
