MONCTON AROUSED OVER INCREASED TELEPHONE RATES

**Methods Adopted by the Big
Company Cause Ill Feeling
—Steps Will be Taken
to Expropriate the Local
System.**

MONCTON, N. B., Nov. 8.—The telephone monopoly commenced to raise rates, and about a week ago an American was brought here to go around and force subscribers to make new contracts at increased rates. This increase of five dollars follows an increase of ten dollars made recently under the plea that desk telephones were being installed instead of the old Blake transmitters. There have been a series of quarrels between subscribers and the agent, the subscribers protesting that the company had the right to give ten days' notice to return the unearned fees and take the telephones out. The agent has apparently not been very happy in his mode of address, introducing a brusque American style and as business men in Moncton are not accustomed to being threatened nor treated as subordinates, the agent has on more than one occasion been reminded by subscribers that they owned their own places of business.

**INVADERS DEATH CHAMBER
TO SERVE A SUMMONS**
conduct of a City Constable Denounced by
[the Magistrate].

Today the civic court was in session, Judge Ritchie presiding. It was one of the largest sessions of the court in years. There were not less than 120 cases to come before the court. Nine of these were cases of assault and battery, and the others were cases of debt and small amounts ranging from about a dollar to thirty dollars. There were the men looking for back rent, the grocer, the coal man, the tailor, the man who was after a balance on a note, and in fact every variety of debts were represented.

One lady who sued a young dry goods clerk for board presented a book showing the amount owing her and stated that when a board bill was presented she would not sign it until she had seen the book. The young clerk summoned to court this morning denied owing the amount and the case was adjourned for a week. The magistrate took occasion to remark that on the above case the constable had been given the summons to serve on Thursday and the young man was not served until the following Wednesday. He did not wish to speak harshly about the constables but this summons should not have been given so late. He was sorry to say that it had been reported to him that a constable had used very bad judgment in serving a summons a few days ago when he entered a house where there was a corpse. The summons was for a relative of the dead person and it is reported to the court that the constable walked round the coffin and served the summons. Nearly every person respects the dead and on such an occasion the constable could have well awaited a better opportunity even if it had caused more trouble.

Of the 120 cases there was none of any great importance, but some took up considerable time and when the court adjourned about noon the docket was exhausted and the defendants cases all finished.

STILL ANOTHER SEARCH FOR CREAMER CHILDREN

**F. W. Sumner Is Sending Constable
Thomas to Have a Last Look Before

MONCTON, N. B., Nov. 8.—So confident is F. W. Sumner, of this city, that the Creamer children's bodies are to be found in the woods adjacent to their homes at Bayfield, Westmorland County, that he has given fifty dollars to Constable Charles H. Thomas, of this city, to carry on a last search before the snow falls. On Monday, Mr. Thomas leaves for Bayfield, and he has been authorized to hire a couple of local men who are thoroughly conversant with the woods to assist him in the search. He will remain at Bayfield until the first of December, if the weather permits, boarding at the house near the Creamer home, which is now unoccupied since the breaking up of the family.
