### Synopsis of Canadian North-west Land Regulations

Any person who is the sole head of a family, or any male over 18 years old, who has a quarter-section of a Dominion Land in Manitoba, Saskatchewan or Alberta. The applicant must apply at the Department of the Interior, Ottawa, or at the Dominion Lands Agency or Sub-Agency for the district. Entry by proxy may be made at any agency, or by his or her father, mother, son, daughter, brother or sister of intending homesteaders. A homesteader may live on the land in each of three years. A homesteader may live on a farm of at least 80 acres solely owned and occupied by him or her, or by his or her father, mother, son, daughter, brother or sister. In certain districts a homesteader may, at his option, acquire a quarter-section of land in a pre-emption. A homesteader may not acquire a quarter-section of land in each of three years. A homesteader who has exhausted his homestead rights cannot obtain a pre-emption. A homesteader must reside six months in each of three years, or the time required to earn honest and useful and cultivate fifty acres extra.
