BEST CATCHER IN LEAGUE

Chicago, Aug. 24.—Manager Callahan of the White Sox declares that Ray Schalk, the diminutive backstop of his team, is the best catcher in the big leagues. Most sporting writers would agree with Callahan when all points of the game are considered. Schalk goes after bunted balls faster than any other catcher. He is an excellent batter, being particularly strong on hit and run plays, and he is an unusually quick thinker. He outguesses his opponents with regularity. In a recent game with Washington the Senators had three men on bases and none out in the first half of the ninth with the score tied. Johnson was pitching and was going good, and it looked like one run would win the game. Griffith decided on a squeeze play to get that run. Schalk guessed the play, called for a pitch out, grabbed the ball and by a burst of speed tagged Porter, who was headed home from third and then gave the ball a flip which enabled another Washington player to be erased between second and third.
