No. For then Primary Lodges might be in debt to the District Treasury and yet have the Annual. Members of Primary Lodges should only get the Annual from their own Master; he from the District Master, who should get it from the C. M. This is the proper *modus operandi* in the case.

Mark Armstrong Should the County Master give the Annual to Masters of Primary Lodges?
