Unseated on petition, 30 July 1875; re-elected 1875, and 1879. First returned to Commons at last g.e. A Liberal Conservative. "Unbiassed by prejudice and untrammelled by party, he will ever endeavour to record his vote upon all questions to the best of his judgment and according to the dictates of his conscience."—Leamington, Out.

WILLIAMS, Lieut.-Col. ARTHUR TREFUSIS HENEAGE. (East Durham.)

S. of John Tucker Williams, Esq., a Commander in the Royal Navy, who sat for Durham in Can. Assem. from 1840 to 1848. B. at Penryn Park, Port Hope, Ont., 1837. Ed. at U.C. Coll. and Edinburgh Univ. M. the dau. of Hon. Senator Seymour. (She d. 1882.) A farmer. Is Lieut. Col. commanding 46th "East Durham" Batt. V. M. Charman of the Port Hope Harbour Commrs.; Presdt. of the Midland Loan and Savings Co. and a dir. of the Midland Railway. Commanded the Wimbledon Team of Riflemen in 1880. First returned for E. Durham, in Ont. Leg. at g.e. 1867. Re-elected by acclamation at g.e. 187; First elected to Commons at g.e. 1878, and again at last g.e. A Conservative.—Penrym Park, Port Hope, Ont.; Toronto Club; Rideau Club.

WILSON, JOHN HENRY, M.D. (East Elgin.)

Grand father a U.E. Loyalist, a veteran of the Am. Revolutionary war. S. of Mr. Jeremiah Wilson. B. near Ottawa, Ont., 14 Feb. 1883. Ed. at the Grammar School, St. Thomas and at Univ. Coll., New York. Graduated M.D. at Victoria Univ., Cobourg, Ont., 1858. M., 1869, at Toledo, Ohio, U.S., Amelia A., dau. of George Ryerson Williams, Esq., of U. E. loyalist descent. Has been Professor of Anatomy in Victoria Univ. Sat. in Leg. Assem., Ont., from g.e. 1871, until g.e. 1879. First returned to Commons at last g.e. A Liberal and opposed to the present Govt.—St. Thomas.
