WELLAND CANAL :—Motion by Mr. Mackenzie, That the contract with H. J. Beemer, for the construction of the works on Section 27, of the Welland Canal, for the sum of \$759,170, was made without inviting tenders for such works, by public advertisement; that the said contract so let, without inviting tenders by public advertisement, and on circulars addressed only to ten persons, was a violation of the law and the policy of Parliament, and deprived the country of the securities and advantages to be derived from adherence to the law and policy which prescribes a free and open competition for such works; that the House cannot approve of said contract; negatived, 356.
