- 4. The application of such fees, and
- 5. Touching the periods of the regular meetings of the Senate and the mode of convening special meetings thereof, and
- 6. The appointment of examiners, officers and servants of the said University, and in like manner the removal of any 5 of them, and
 - 7. Touching the time and the mode of holding an examination of the Candidates as aforesaid, and of the subjects of such examination, and
- 10 8. Generally for promoting the purposes of the said Univerversity, touching all other matters regarding the same, or the business thereof, or for any purpose for which provisions may be required for carrying out the same according to its intent and spirit.

All such Statutes shall be reduced into writing, and the Statutes apcommon seal of the University shall be annexed thereto, and proved by the when they have been approved of by the said Bishop of Kings-binding. ton, they shall be binding upon all members or officers of the University, and upon all candidates for degrees, scholarships, 20 prizes or certificates of honor, to be conferred by the said University, and upon all others whom it may concern.

In order to extend the benefits of Colleges and Esta- Who may be 35 blishments already instituted or to be instituted in this Province admitted as for the promotion of Literature, Science and Art, whether in-degrees. corporated or not incorporated, by connecting them with the said University, all persons shall be admitted as candidates for the respective Degrees of Bachelor of Arts and Master of Arts, 40 in the said University, on satisfying the Senate by proper certificates, that such persons have, in any of the Institutions hereinafter mentioned, gone through and completed such course of instruction as the Senate by Statutes made as aforesaid from time to time determine.
