And for the more speedy proceeding to Condemnation or other Determination of any Prize-Ship or Aestel, Gosds and Werchandizes taken by any fuch Privateer-Ship, or by any of her Wajesties Ships of War in such Court of Admiralty, as aforesaid, and for lestening the Ervences that have been usual in those Cases; Be it surther Enaced by the Authority aforesaid, That the Judge or Judges of such Court of Admiralty, or other Person or Persons thereto Authoused, that within the space of five Days after request to hint or them for that purpole made, finish the ulual Preparatory Eramination of the Persons commonly Examined in such Cases, in D2der to prove the Capture to be Lawful Prize, or to Enquire whe ther the same be Lawful Prize or not; and that the proper Bonution usual in such Cales shall be issued by the Person or Persons proper to fine the fame, and hall be Erecuted in the usual Panner by the Person or Persons proper to Erecute the same, within the space of Three Days after request in that behalf made; and in Tale no Claim of such Capture, Ship. Wellel or Goods thail be duly entred or made in the ulual form, and Attested upon Dath, giving Twenty Days Notice after the Execution of such Bonicion, or if there be such Claim, and the Claimant or Claimants hall not within five Days give sufficient Security ( to be approved by such Court of Admiralty) to pay double Cous to the Captor or Captors of such Ship, Clessel or Goods, in case the same so Claimed thall be Adjudged Lawful Prize, Chat then the Judge or Judges of fuch Court of Idmiralty thall, upon producing to him or them the laid Graminations of Copies thereof, and upon producing to him or them. upon Dath, all Papers and Writings which hall have been found taken in or with such Capture (or upon Dath made that no such Davers were found) immediarely, and without further Delay proceed to Sentence, either to Ducharge and Acquit luch Capture, or to Admoge or Condemn the fame as Lawful Prize, according as the Tale thall appear to him of them, upon Perulal of luch Prevaratory Craminations, and also of the Wiritings found taken in or with such Capture (if any such Writing Hall be found;) and in Case fuch Claim that be duly entred of made, and Security given thereupon, according to the Tends and true Bearing of this As, and there hall appear no Occasion to Cranine any Witnesses, other than what thall be then near to fuch Court of Nomicalty. That then fuch Judge of Judges hall forthwith coule such Wifnelles to be Examined, and (within the space of Ten Days after such Claim made. and Security given) proceed to luch Sentence, as eforeleid, touch ing fuch Capture; But in Case upon making or entring such Claim, and the Allenation and Dath thereupon, or the woducing fuch Withings as thall have been found taken in, or with luch Capture, or upon the fair Preparatory Examinations it thall appear doubtful to the Judge of Judges of luch Court of Idmiralty, whether luch Capture be Lawful Prize or not; and it hall appear necellary accoiding to the Circumilances of the Cale, for the Clearing and Determining such Doubt, to have an Cramination of Wituenes that are Remote from Juch Court of Admirater, and Just Crami-Bbbbbb nation
