
BILL.

An Act to incorporate the Jewish Congregation *Anshe-Sholem* of Hamilton.

WHEREAS the Members of the Hebrew Benevolent Society *Anshe-Sholem*, of Hamilton, hereinafter named, have by their petition set forth that they have in contemplation the erection of a Synagogue and have prayed to be incorporated, and it is expedient to grant their prayer ;

Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of Canada, enacts as follows :

1. Jacob Frey, Isaac Levy, Henry Zinsherner, Samuel Desbecker, Leopold Rosenband, Daniel Shire, Simon Shire, Leopold Loeb, Isaac Shire, William Loeb, Mendel Levy, Abraham Levy, Iberman Levy, Jonas Draenger, Solomon Ungar, H. Wolf, Bernhard Weinberg, Abraham Saimon, and Louis Daniels, together with such other persons as may hereafter become members of the said Society, shall be and they are hereby constituted a Body Corporate and Politic under the name of the Jewish Congregation *Anshe-Sholem*, of Hamilton, and by that name shall have power, from time to time, and at any time hereafter, to purchase, hold, possess and enjoy, for themselves and their successors, Lands and Hereditaments in Upper Canada not exceeding the value of Five Thousand Pounds, for the purposes of a Synagogue and Schools and other buildings requisite for the use of the said Congregation, and also for a burying-ground, and from time to time to sell, alienate, and dispose of the said lands and hereditaments and to purchase and acquire other lands and hereditaments instead thereof, for the same purposes, and from time to time as occasion may require to mortgage or charge the said lands and hereditaments, or any part thereof.

General powers.
2. The officers of the said Congregation shall consist of a President, a Vice-president, a Treasurer and a Secretary, who shall be elected by Ballot by the members for the time being of the said congregation annually, at the annual general meeting to be held on the first day of October in every year, or on such other day as may be appointed by the by-laws of the said congregation ; and the officers so appointed shall have the right to exercise such powers and authorities for the due management and administration of the affairs of the congregation as may be conferred upon them by the regulations and by-laws of the said congregation.

Annual meeting.
3. The present officers of the said Society shall continue in office until their successors shall be appointed at the first annual meeting of the said congregation to be held next after the passing of this Act.
