who will exercise a legal and proper discretion upon it, both as to form and matter; and that from the moment it is filed, it becomes, as in all Courts, the property of the House, and can in no case be withdrawn, or altered, or amended, but with the consent of the House previously obtained.

XIV.

That no Member, absent when the Absent question in discussion has passed the may not House, can be admitted to Protest at all.

XV.

That all Orders of the Day, which Orders of the Day by reason of any adjourment shall not not prohave been proceeded upon, shall be ceeded one how disconsidered only as postponed to the posed of. next day on which the House shall sit.

XVI.

To prevent misunderstanding, and Personal, for avoiding offensive Speeches when &c., to be matters forborne.
