

"resignation per se," said Bryden. "To say she is retiring June 30 would be a better way of putting it."

Bryden described Bata as a "valued member" of the Board. "As Chairman I have found her contribution and commitment to the University very useful and very positive," he said.

Bryden said the May 7 petition was not relevant in light of the timing of his discussions with Bata. "Since Sonja had already indicated her position some months earlier I didn't think it was an issue," he said.

However, Himbara said the petition demonstrated the extent of the pressure that had begun to mount against Bata. He described supporters of the petition as "extremely enthusiastic," and said it has been an "on-going effort" for almost a year to see Bata removed from her position on the BOG.
